ZOOM PROCEDURES:

- All parties and Counsel who have filed papers in connection with a calendared matter: the Courtroom Deputy will email you an invitation to join the Zoom Webinar two (2) days prior to the hearing. Please make sure your email address is correct.
- Parties or Counsel who have not filed papers but wish to attend the hearing: Please contact the Courtroom Deputy no less than two (2) days prior to the hearing by email at anna_e_lee@canb.uscourts.gov to request an invitation to the Zoom Webinar. The Courtroom Deputy will email you an invitation prior to the hearing. They will attend in LISTEN-ONLY MODE.
- When signing into the Zoom Webinar, please enter **FIRST AND LAST NAME AND CASE NAME**.
- Please sign into the Zoom Webinar **15 minutes early**.
- Do not forward or share the Zoom Webinar invitation with anyone.
- All parties must wear business casual attire.

PHONE PROCEDURES:
