The Courtroom Deputy will email you an invitation prior to the hearing. They will attend in LISTEN-ONLY MODE.
- When signing into the Zoom Webinar, please enter **FIRST AND LAST NAME AND CASE NAME**.
- Please sign into the Zoom Webinar **15 minutes early**.
- Do not forward or share the Zoom Webinar invitation with anyone.
- All parties must wear business casual attire.
- Failure to timely follow these procedures may result in a party or counsel's appearance being waived.

PHONE PROCEDURES:

- Parties who dial-in via phone are in LISTEN-ONLY MODE, unless the court instructs otherwise.
- Attorneys and others intending to appear and be heard on matters on the calendar should **not** register with CourtCall as they had in the past.
