# ZOOM PROCEDURES:

- → All parties and Counsel who have filed papers in connection with a calendared matter: the Courtroom Deputy will email you an invitation to join the Zoom Webinar two (2) days prior to the hearing. Please make sure your email address is correct.
- → Parties or Counsel who have <u>not filed papers</u> but wish to attend the hearing: Please contact the Courtroom Deputy no less than two (2) days prior to the hearing by email at <u>anna e lee@canb.uscourts.gov</u> to request an invitation to the Zoom Webinar. The Courtroom Deputy will email you an invitation prior to the hearing. They will attend in LISTEN-ONLY MODE.
- $\rightarrow$  When signing into the Zoom Webinar, please enter **FIRST AND LAST NAME AND CASE NAME**.
- $\rightarrow$  Please sign into the Zoom Webinar **15 minutes early.**
- $\rightarrow$  Do <u>not</u> forward or share the Zoom Webinar invitation with anyone.
- $\rightarrow$  All parties must wear business casual attire.
- $\rightarrow$  Failure to timely follow these procedures may result in a party or counsel's appearance being waived.
